



Winter Maintenance Checklist:

Areas to check:	Checked?	Comments:
Walkthrough of the boat to check overall appearance. (Look for chips, scratches, stress cracks and damage to gel coating)		
Engine winterisation and general maintenance (E.g. change the engine oil and lubricate fittings)		
Get your sterndrive/leg serviced. (Every 1-2 years)		
Check deck fittings for potential for water damage		
Check steering (examine keel and rudder and check linkages and wires)		
Examine electrical systems (Batteries and light bulbs)		
Clean, wax and inspect the hull (Look for a chalk like appearance and any damage to gel coating)		



Anti-foul the hull (Once a year for boats used on the sea, every other year for boats on fresh water.)		
Check your anodes and propeller blades and replace if 1/3 decayed. (Look for any damage or pink-ish discolouration)		
Tidy and clean your bilge. Look for any leaks.		
Clean and tidy the interior. (Install a dehumidifier and ensure boat is completely sealed)		
Check canopy for any breaches/damage. May need waterproofing.		
Plan any cosmetic upgrades (E.g. to upholstery or kitchen and bathroom fittings)
